





Internal Seminar on Communication Skill development Programme

A one-day workshop on Communication Skills Development for the students of **Pragnya College of Management & Computer Studies** BBA First Year stream was organised at the Institute from 10 am to 12 pm on 23/02/2022 for the session 2021-2022.

The workshop was inaugurated by the faculty of our College, **Prof. Vishwanath Jha** in the presence of our principle urged the participants to make use of the workshop to the maximum extent possible in order to enhance their communication skills – both oral and written.

The following points has been covered during the sessions:

- During the first session of the workshop, Prof. Vishwanath Jha made a presentation on Basic Writing Skills which covered areas like Punctuation, Commonly Confused words and Basic Grammar. After the presentation, the participants were asked few questions on these areas and their performance was evaluated and necessary feedback on how to improve these skills was given.
- 2. In the second session, a presentation on Business Email Writing, which gave necessary tips and guidelines on drafting formal emails, was followed by the participants' drafting emails in groups on their own on some given topics. They were made to read out the drafts and necessary corrections and clarifications were suggested by the resource person.
- 3. During the first session in the afternoon, the participants were given some useful information on telephone etiquettes. Then they were given some exercises and role play sessions where they were asked to use appropriate language both formal and informal while making telephonic conversations.
- 4. In the last session, the resource person gave some useful information and tips on drafting business/official letters and the participants were asked to work in groups and write out formal letters making use of the tips and following the guide lines given.

In total 43 students of BBA Semester II has attended the sessions. In the valedictory address, the Principal congratulated both the participants and the resource persons for organizing the programme successfully and requested the participants to constantly improve upon their skills and competencies for their personal and professional growth. The program ended with a vote of thanks by Prof. Vishwanath Jha.


